Cascade Clamp - Founded in Portland, Oregon in 1943, the Cascade Manufacturing Company started as a small machine shop hiring just 4 individuals. Total sales for that particular year amounted to about 60 thousand dollars. The very first recorded sales revenues involved the assembly and machining of stainless steel pipe fittings, valves and various components. Within 5 years of operation, the business had expanded to 40 workers and their yearly sales volume had risen to three hundred thirty thousand dollars. At present, Cascade is one of the leading worldwide producers within the material handling trade.

Design and manufacturing of the company's first hydraulic cylinder allowed this new business to aggressively engage in better business possibilities. All through the final sixty years, the industry of material handling has developed into a really sophisticated field with Cascade proudly playing a part in its growth. Cascade at the moment continues to grow as the leader provider of forklift attachments and various related products. The business feels assured in their potential to be able to continue to lead the way within the business by understanding buyer's requirements in the future and remaining aggressive in the global market.

In the 1950's, Cascade started designing, fabricating and advertising hydraulic accessories. Construction was done in 1956 on a brand new facility in order to house all plant and office operations in Portland, Oregon at the company's present headquarters. Subsequent to fifteen years of business, total workers reached a hundred and eighty workers and sales had reached practically two million three hundred thousand dollars.

1959 in Springfield, Surprise a second production facility was built. 1960 marked Cascade's initial move into the international world of the material handling industry as the business established interest in Australia, the Netherlands and England.

In the year 1964, the business changed its name to the Cascade Corporation. After that in the year 1965, the business went public with a preliminary offering of 200,000 shares of common stock. Ever since then the business has expanded its manufacturing amenities throughout the continental USA to the areas Warner Robins Georgia to go along with its already current plants in Springfield, Surprise and Portland, Oregon. Cascade merchandise are fabricated globally thanks to lots of subsidiary operations. In the year 1944, a new facility was completed in Almere, the Netherlands which is Cascade's European control center. This plant is designed to be the essential customer support centre.

Continuing to grow, Cascade expanded their product offering further in the year 1996 and 1997 with the remarkable acquisition of five companies, including the global best in forks, the Kenhar Corporation.
